Repertoire Requirements

CD

A CD of excellent quality at least thirty minutes duration must be submitted, that would illustrate the extent of technical command, variety of interpretative abilities, understanding of performance styles as well as special repertoire interests. Please do not include concerto works on the CD.

It is to your advantage that the CD be of the highest possible artistic and audio quality.

Auditions

Applicants must submit and be prepared to perform at least two full programs that illustrate repertoire interest and which could possibly form the basis for two New York recitals. Both programs must include works with a wide range of musical character. One major 20th century American work of 18 minutes or more in length must be included in one of your programs. These programs must be included in your application.

In addition the contestant must submit two concertos:

- One from the Classical or Romantic period
- One from the 20th century; Sibelius must be deemed a Romantic work – NOT 20th century
